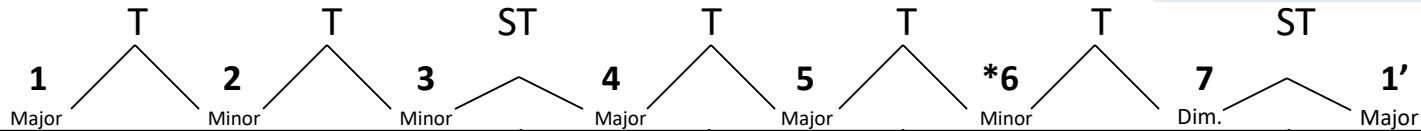


T= Tone = 2 Frets

# The Language Cheat Sheet

\* All Major Scales have a Relative Minor Scale (the Natural Minor) that shares the same notes. Start the natural minor scale on the 6<sup>th</sup> note (the 6<sup>th</sup> degree) of the major scale.

# = Sharp Keys  
Enharmonic: Same sound, different name.

\*\*Minor Scale Formula    1    2    b3    4    5    b6    b7    1
